2. Programme

Our Artistic programme combines a wide range of activity from new commissions, solo and group exhibitions, events, talks, workshops and research trips. The artistic programme is selected by our curatorial team and aims to respond to current conversations happening within art and the broader climate.

Open Calls

Throughout the year we have a series of open call opportunities. Some of these opportunities are available to artists and creative's who are currently part of our Membership Scheme as well as some that are available to the wider public.

We had an open call for our annual Members Show in 2018, 2019 and 2020, with two of these open calls being selected by a guest curator. We also had an open call for our Members to submit work to be included in our billboard programme in both 2019 and 2020. In addition to these open calls specifically for our Membership, we also had an open call in 2018 for artists and creative's based in Sheffield to be involved in an international research trip to Bergen, Norway.
